No extreme sports today! This will be a test of your intellect, team work and, of course, as we are true consultants, your best Google search and map reading skills. In your teams, you will be solving clues to find and travel to these East London locations. Use public transport at your own risk– I have designed the game so that everywhere is in walking distance of where you are right now (though you will certainly get some exercise this afternoon!) so if you're on a train you're probably headed in the wrong direction. In order to prove that your team made it to a location successfully, I have asked to see photos of the team / interworks business card at that location. Please send all pics to me via slack. Sometimes the photo requirement is very specific, so read the instructions carefully, also I will of course award bonus points for style. I will pick up phone calls, texts, slack– if you are stuck/lost or need more clues then ping me.

CLUE #1 – where? The first clue is easy - this little gem has been a concert hall, ale house, Methodist mission, rag sorting house and derelict–it is now restored to something like its former glory as a 1870s music hall. Take a team photo in the alley outside with your best theatrical ensemble pose.

CLUE #2 –which number? If you wore a black shirt you wouldn't have been allowed to pass through here on Sunday October 4th 1936. Bottom right of the mural you will see some numbers which are partly obscured. Note them all down in order left to right within the FINISH LINE clue below.



CLUE #3 –how? In its heyday this was a huge cinema with floor to ceiling mirrors, Hollywood guests and a revolving stage. How did staff famously add to that sense of luxury during film showings? Pick someone in your team to do their best impression of a film-goer enjoying this part of the service once at this location.

CLUE #4 – who? You might use this company if you wanted to explore the waterways of East London. The cartoon image clue tells you the company name – head over to their HQ to take a pic of your business card.



CLUE #5 – where? this traditional English nursery rhyme and singing game refers to locations: "oranges and lemons, said the bells of St Clements... Pray when will that be, said the bells of Stepney?"-where would you find ten bells of Stepney? Team photo please!

CLUE #6 – what? This somewhat seedy East End boozer played host to the murder of George Cornell by which notorious East End bad boys? The person who shot George was later committed to a mental hospital in 1958 – you will need the name of that institution to complete your FINISH LINE clue.
